Re: Discussion with Dr. Morey

Dear Mr. Welty,

It has come to the attention of the board of directors of Faith Defenders Church, Inc., a California Religious Nonprofit Corporation (hereinafter "FD"), that you have contacted Dr. Robert Morey with a request for payment for certain work that you performed involving the comic book "Mohammad's Believe It or Else" and the web site www.Islamiccomicbook.com. Once you contacted Dr. Robert Morey with this request, a board meeting was called per FD policy and all of the directors of Faith Defenders Church, Inc., met to discuss this conversation and request for funds.

On March 1, 2006, the board of directors of FD met. The current board of Directors consists of Dr. Robert Morey, Cynthia Ortiz and Mark Ziebold. The items discussed at this meeting centered around your use of copyrighted material owned by FD, as FD has purchased the copyright on "Mohammad's Believe It or Else" from Crescent Moon Publications. Your use was not sanctioned by the board of directors of FD, nor was the creation of merchandise featuring images of the comic book authorized for your reproduction for sale.

While Dr. Morey is the President of FD, he cannot unilaterally make decisions regarding the ministry, church, university, assets of FD or any other nonprofit corporation associated with FD such as the Research and Education Foundation. It is a firm policy of the ministry that any decisions regarding payments to outside contractors (non-employees) require an affirmative vote by the board of directors and a written agreement between FD and the contractor. Anyone who does any work for the ministry outside of a written agreement is treated as a volunteer and will not be monetarily compensated for the work that they perform.

The Board of Directors then discussed your use of the above described materials and held a vote on your current and future use of the materials. Against Dr. Morey's wishes, Cynthia Ortiz and Mark Ziebold voted to have FD refrain from making any payment to you for any work that was done on the comic book or any of the translations of the comic

book. This decision is primarily based on two reasons: 1) the lack of a written agreement between yourself and FD and 2) your use of copyrighted FD materials for your own profit. Furthermore, the two directors above made the following corporate resolutions that were voted on and passed by a majority vote (consisting of Cynthia Ortiz and Mark Ziebold) at the corporate meeting: **1) You shall immediately stop using and refrain from using the comic book "Mohammad's Believe it or Else" in any written or electronic manner in the future. 2) You shall immediately stop selling merchandise containing images from the comic book, or inspired by the comic book, for a profit. 3) Any future use of the comic book must be approved in writing by the board of directors of Faith Defenders Church, Inc. 4) You shall not receive any funding from the ministry for any of the work that has been done in violation of ministry policies including the "editing" of the comic book, translation of the comic book into various languages, and any other work that you allege to have done.**

If you are found to be using the comic book in any way after fifteen (15) days of receipt of this letter, the board of directors will consider other remedies against you including, but not limited to, the following: **Filing a lawsuit against you in Orange County Superior Court seeking an injunction to prevent you from using the comic book, filing separate counts in the lawsuit alleging damages in the amount of money that you have made on the sales of merchandise and seeking Church Discipline against you for improper use of FD copyrighted property and improper allegations that the property belongs to you.** These remedies shall be pursued against you if you continue to use the copyrighted materials without the express written consent of the board of directors of FD.


If you have any questions or concerns regarding this letter, you may contact the board of directors in writing or by phone within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Any concerns must be brought to the next board meeting and will be discussed at that time. If you prefer, a special board meeting will be called within fifteen (15) days of your written response to discuss this matter. If you do not respond in writing within the initial fifteen (15) day period, the board of directors of FD shall consider this issue closed and shall take any necessary steps outlined above.

We pray that you cease your current activities before any of the above remedies are pursued against you.
